Have a great half term. It looks like the sun is going to shine.

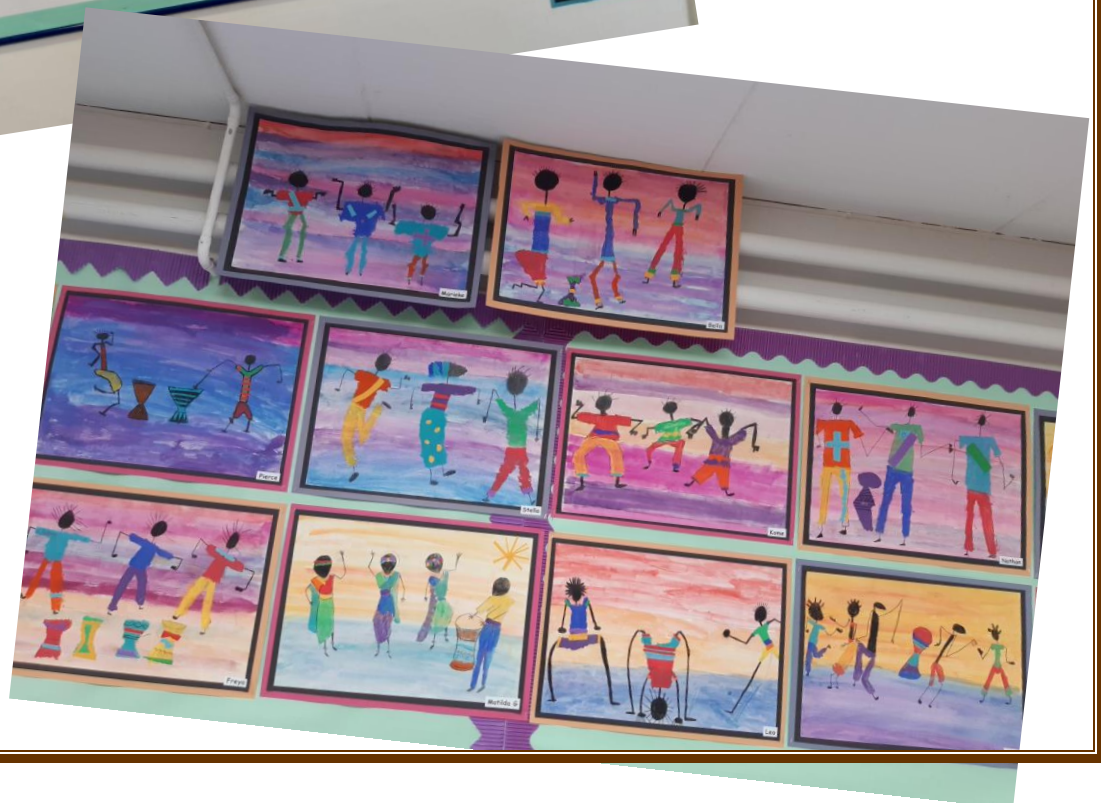
