

**BOUNDARIES OF THE PARISH OF ST COLUMBA, CHESHAM
(2015 clarification)**

These descriptions are intended to be read in conjunction with an Ordnance Survey 1:50,000 scale map, and a 1:25,000 one if possible, and possibly a large-scale street map.

Beginning at the most northerly point and running clockwise

1. Starting from the point on Shire Lane between Cholesbury and Hastoe, which is also the Bucks/Herts county boundary, where it runs between Shrubbs Wood (and Haresgarden Wood, named as such only on Google Maps) and Drayton Wood, grid ref. 923083 (see Map A)
2. Generally south-east following the county boundary for a long distance until the point east of Botley and Ley Hill where it crosses the minor road between Ley Hill and Bovingdon.
3. By a bee-line south-west from there, passing just SE of the sewage works on Latimer Road running SE out of Chesham, and continuing SW to meet the Chesham / Little Chalfont railway.
4. Along the track of that railway NW to where it is crossed by Moor Road
5. NW along Moor Road (north side only) to the roundabout with Amersham Road A416. See Map B for points 5-6
6. From the roundabout, SW along the eastern edges of the cricket and football grounds, and then generally NW so as to include all houses in the built-up area of Chesham leading off Fullers Hill and Missenden Road.
7. Following the Missenden Road B485 generally westwards, but running south of the road so as to include all farms and houses on both sides of the road, as far as the point where the lane running north from Hawthorn Farm (north of Hyde Heath) meets the B485.
8. From there, by a long bee-line running NNW and passing west of Chartridge so as to include it, to a point on the road between Buckland and St Leonards where a lane leads off southwards towards a copse marked on the 1:25,000 map as Ashen Grove. See Map A for points 8 (end) and 9
9. From there, by a bee-line NNE to our starting point on the county boundary

Main villages and neighbourhoods included: Chesham Ashley Green, Bellingdon, Botley, Buckland Common, Chartridge, , Cholesbury, Ley Hill, Lye Green, Orchard Leigh, Pednor Bottom.

Excluded (for the avoidance of doubt): Ballinger Common, Chesham Bois, Flaunden, Hyde Heath, St Leonards, South Heath, The Lee

Developments: No substantial housing developments are likely in this hilly and intensively-settled Green Belt area.
