Dear Parents and Children,

At Our Lady's we follow the National Curriculum 2014. This leaflet gives a brief outline of the knowledge and skills being learned in the curriculum in your class this term. A map of our whole school curriculum can be found on the school website.

Religious Education – We follow the 'Come and See' programme which ensures we cover the curriculum set out by the Bishops of England and Wales. The whole school will cover the same themes with each class approaching it in a different way.

Theme	Learning
Local Church <i>community</i>	Books – the books used in church
Eucharist <i>relating</i>	Thanksgiving – Mass; a special time to thank God
Lent/Easter <i>giving</i>	Opportunities – Lent: an opportunity to start anew

Literacy – In Literacy this term, we will be developing writing in particular through the following forms of writing: **Letter writing** and **Stories with a repeating phrase**.

The children need to focus on the following skills in particular:

Sentence structure (correct punctuation)
Writing speech – punctuation
Past tense
Paragraphs

Numeracy – This term we will be focusing on the following key skills:

Addition and Subtraction 2-digit numbers
Multiplication & division
Times tables
Geometry
Fractions
Data handling
Money

In the rest of the curriculum, we will be concentrating on the following areas of learning:
