Key Stage 1 – Reading Book Helpers

We would really appreciate some help changing the reading books in Key Stage 1. As you can imagine it is a bit of a mammoth task and we are very limited on the number of staff we have available to do this. Ideally, we want the teaching assistants working with the children rather than changing books, so if you can offer a few hours a week then please let Mrs Lally or Mrs Copley know.

White Rose – Maths App for Reception and Key Stage 1

White Rose have released a new app which can be used by children in Key Stage 1 or Reception, or children in Key Stage 2 who are struggling with some basic number work.

1-Minute Maths offers children engaging and easily accessible practice in basic number. There's no specific route or starting point. Having chosen a topic, each user answers a series of randomly generated questions (a different set of questions every time means they learn the concept, not a sequence of answers).

When the one minute's up, the questions are automatically marked and presented on a breakdown screen, giving instant feedback on how they've done. If they're struggling with a question, a 'Hint' button reformats the

question as a familiar manipulative display that mirrors the approaches used in the White Rose Maths schemes of learning.

Knife and Fork – We need your help






