Fundraising for the Poor Servants of the Mother of God (Kenya)

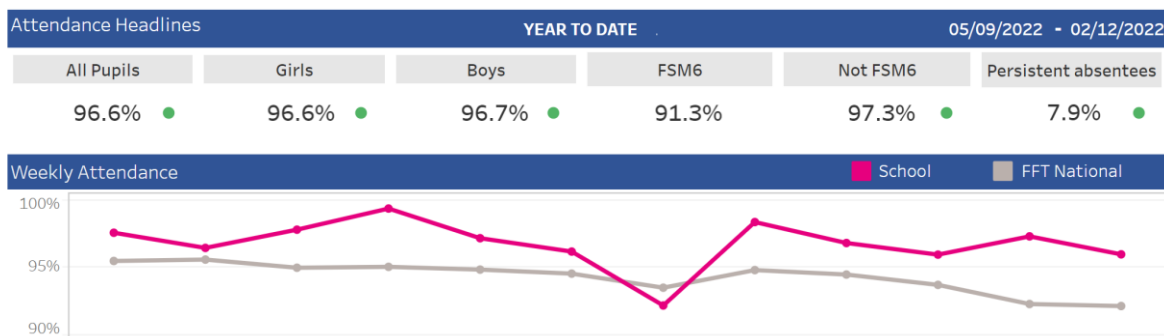

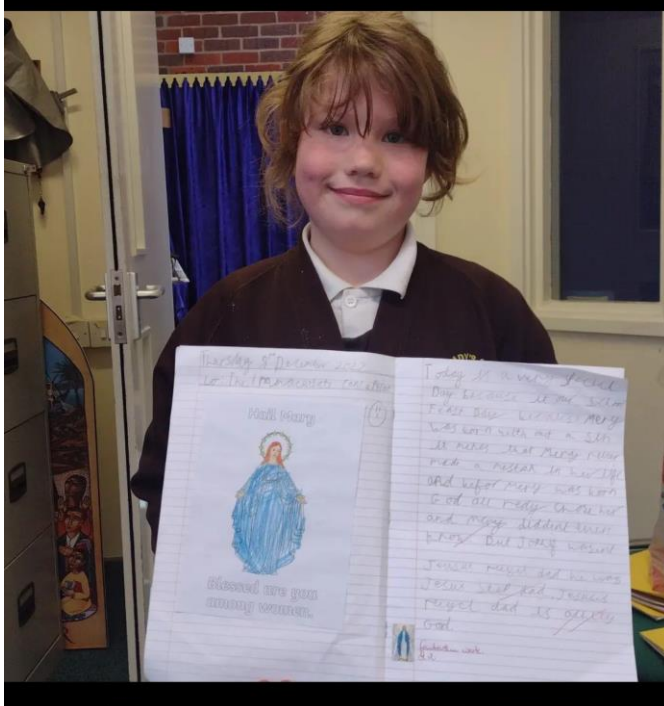
