This week and next week are our induction weeks. We have a slightly different timetable to give the children the chance to learn new routines. They all seem very keen to get started in their new class with their new teacher.


On Tuesday in assembly, we thought about how if we don't involve Jesus in our lives then there is something missing and we can't really fulfil our true potential.



Cafod Family Fast Day

The 7th October is Cafod's Family Fast Day and, as has become our tradition, St Joseph's will be supplying us with soup and a roll for our school lunch. I would like to encourage children to have a school lunch that day and we will donate the money you pay to Cafod. Not only is this a really good way to raise money but it also helps our children to show solidarity with hungry children across the world.

School Uniform

The children are looking very smart this week in their new school uniform. Please remember how important it is that you send them in looking smart and in the correct uniform. If they aren't in the correct uniform, they are less likely to follow the school rules because they know what the rules around uniform are, and they are learning that you think it is alright to overstep the boundaries.

The things to take particular notice of are that they are wearing PLAIN stud earrings, like the ones in the picture, and no makeup or hair gel. They also need plain black shoes and black or brown tights or socks. Also, please would parents make sure that if their children's hair is longer than collar length (girls or boys), it is tied up with a yellow, brown, black or white, discrete hair band.



Thank you for your support. It makes my job really unpleasant if I am having to tell children off about their uniform when I know it is really up to parents to comply.

Punctuality

At the start of the year it is important to remind parents about the importance of punctuality. I think during the pandemic we had to be a bit more flexible which has left us with a few bad habits. It is really important to know that although we have a "soft" start some really important skills are practised during registration. This is also one of the best times for teaching assistants to intervene when children have misconceptions or haven't understood something from the day before. Often the children who are late are the ones who struggle for the rest of the day. The timings for the morning are:

- 1) 8.40 am Doors open for Key Stage 2
- 2) 8.45 am Key Stage 1 children collected
- 3) 8.55 am Official start of the school day after this your child is late.
- 4) 9.05 am registration closes after this your child gets marked as late after the register is closed which legally counts as an absence.

At the start of the new year, please could I remind parents that they shouldn't be using the car park at the beginning and end of the day unless they are dropping off for the Breakfast Club or collecting from the After School Club. Cars and children really don't mix very well.

Also, please could parents remember to park considerately in the surrounding roads. It is really important that you don't park too close to the junction and make sure that you only park on one side of the road. It seems that often people who are running late double park, so please make sure you leave enough time to park and walk what is only a very short distance.
